- **Art journal** Suggested journal: Strathmore Mixed Media Art Journal with 190 g/m² paper, 5,5" x 8,5" (14 x 21,6cm) ★
- **A few small sheets of water colour paper** Suggestion: Fabriano Water Colour postcards 300 g/m² ★
- **Flat brushes** 5mm, 10mm, 25mm
- **Round brush** size 2 or 4, size 10 or 12
- **Old credit card / plastic pass**
- **Mechanical pencil**
- **Eraser & sharpener**
- **Glue & scissors**
- **Black charcoal pencil**
- **Black water colour pencil** Suggested brand: Stabilo All pencil ★

TIPS FOR PEOPLE ON A BUDGET!

- **Art journal** Of course you can use any art journal you want, but cheap journals often don't have a good quality paper in it. If you are on a budget, I suggest you not use an art journal but buy a sketch pad with drawing paper. These are not too expensive and the quality is often pretty good. If you want to be super creative, you can even bind a journal with those papers with needle and thread.
- **Water colour paper** Use drawing paper instead, or work in your journal directly.
- **Brushes** Did you know that the synthetic brushes of dollar stores are often pretty good?
- **Pencil** Any pencil will do, really! A pencil is a pencil.
- **Black charcoal pencil** Replace the black charcoal pencil for the regular pencil.
- **Black water colour pencil** Replace the black water colour pencil for the black water soluble crayon, or the black acrylic paint and a brush.
- **Black fineliner** can be replaced for any pen. (Even with a blue ball pen you can draw.)
- **Acrylic marker** Don't worry about the acrylic marker if you don't have any. Just don't make tiny highlights and details. Life is so much easier anyway if you don't worry about details too much. ;-)
- **Washi tapes** can often be found in dollar stores too. (Save yourself a huge amount of money and buy only 1 and not 26.)
- **Stencils** Cut your own! Use the cover of an old glossy magazine or recycle packages for example.
- **Watercolours** Replace the watercolour travel set for the watersoluble crayons. No, the crayons do not work the same, but when you are on a budget, you have to be creative with what you have! And the crayons are more versatile in use for this e-course.
- **Waterbrush** Just forget about the waterbrush okay? It is a fun tool, but any brush with a cup of water will do.
- **Watersoluble Caran d'ache Neocolor II crayons** Instead of 15 colours, there is also a box with 10 colours available. Or buy a few separate colours.
- **Matte gel medium** I must say I am not so fond of cheaper brands, because they often make your page wrinkle. But, again, in dollar stores you can often find cheaper gel medium.
